



Information on entry from a high-risk area

Persons who enter from a high-risk area and live in the district of Heilbronn are required to register immediately after re-entry in Germany with the Heilbronn Administrative Authority and to go into quarantine directly at home or in another suitable accommodation. The quarantine must be carried out for a period of 10 days. During this period, no visitor may be received, who is not a member of your own household.

You do not have to go into quarantine, for example, if you belong to a certain profession or if you are visiting your spouse who does not live in the same household. Important: You must obligatorily contact your competent public order office immediately following entry from a high-risk area.

If you would like to prematurely end the specified quarantine period, you can arrange to have a coronavirus test from the **fifth day** of being placed under quarantine and submit it to the Administrative Authority. This medical certificate must meet the requirements of the Robert Koch Institute. The test

- must not be carried out until the fifth day **after** entry into Germany at the earliest,
- must make reference to coronavirus testing (molecular biological testing or antigen test), <u>and</u>
- must confirm that there is no evidence of infection with the coronavirus.

How do I report my re-entry to the Heilbronn Administrative Authority?

The notification to the Administrative Authority must be made in writing at the e-mail address <u>veranstaltungen@heilbronn.de</u>. Any person who has entered and lives in the Heilbronn district must send the e-mail and the following information must be passed on to the Administrative Authority:

- 5. professional activity and employer
- 6. date of entry
- 7. the country from which you have entered
- 8. reason for staying abroad
